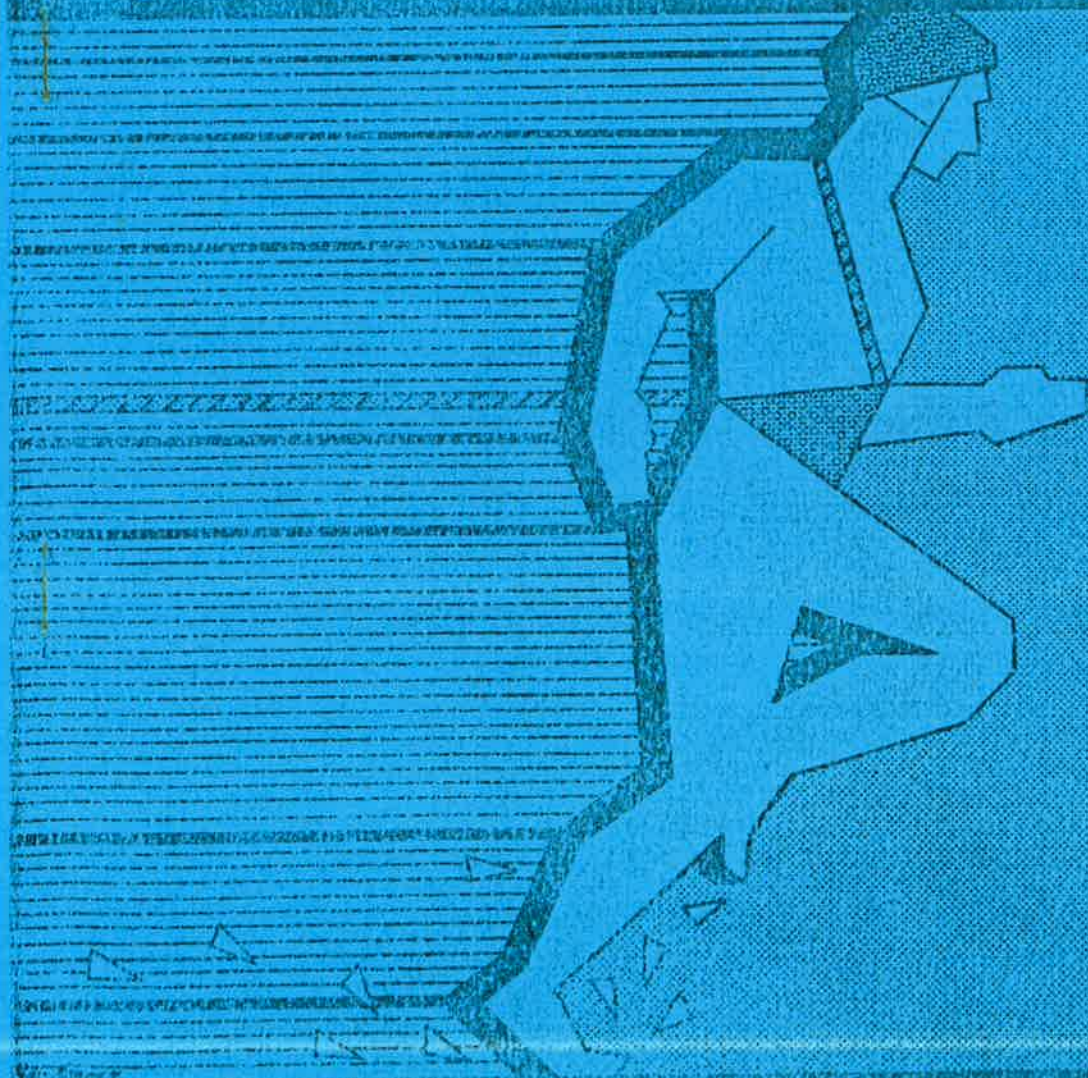

I would like to remind you that A. R. C. S. will have to requalify in late October to early November and Bronze Medallions will requalify early in December and so I strongly recommend everybody starts training now for next season.
