## CLUB CAPTAINS REPORT 1983 - 84.

Season 1983 - 1984 again saw our club expanding both in manpower and gear. The increase in active membership from 36 to 50 members has now made Cape Paterson larger than many other Victorian clubs. This active membership, our success in the patrol competition, and our members high morale has made us the envy of many Victorian clubs.

### PATROLS.

The increase in manpower and the increased experience of all our members has lead to an improvement in patrolling this season.

Patrols were generally consciencously manned for the majority of the season but as usual enthusiasum fell off toward the end. Manpower on the beach was maintained due to the training of a bronze squad very late in the season.

The members of each patrol were expected to spend a total number of hours on patrol:

<u>PATROL 1.</u>	64 Hours.
<u>PATROL 2.</u>	60 Hours.
<u>PATROL 3.</u>	56 Hours.
<u>PATROL 4.</u>	57.5 Hours.

The following list is a compilation of logged hours spent patrolling by each member. I am pleased to see that at least the Patrol Captains did their rostered number of hours plus some extra.

Season 1983/84 was longer than previous seasons by 2 weekends and so each member was expected to spend about 7 hours extra patrolling compared to last season. Generally this didn't happen and many people didn't do their rostered hours. A small group of members did over double the hours they did last season, I congratulate them and all the members who pulled their weight and made season 83/84 the smoothest running I can remember.

### PATROL COMPETITION.

Cape Paterson came second in the patrol competition in the state AGAIN. We were only four points behind Gunnamatta. (Those who got questions wrong - PANIC!)

We scored 1432 out of 1440 points; for winning the district we have won a rescue tube and for second in the state a rescue malibu, first prize was an I.R.B. Motor.

## CHIEF INSTRUCTORS REPORT.

With the addition of fifteen successful Bronze Candidates this season we have forty one bronze holders, ample numbers in my opinion to keep the individual workload to an enjoyable level with everyone helping.

A total of fifty two awards were gained, the bulk of the training was undertaken by five members who gained seven instructors awards between them.

At least one crewman and one driver are required to man the Inflatable Rescue Boat (I.R.B.) on each patrol. We now have thirteen crewmen with six crewman's certificates gained. We have four newly qualified drivers which were much needed. We started the season with one qualified driver, Ashley Reid, who virtually had to be on every patrol.

Thirteen Radio Operators Certificates (R.O.C.) and three Radio Instructors Certificates (R.I.C.) were gained at a seminar organised by our District Supervisor, Rick Mitchell and the State Centre Radio sub-committee. The Radio network is essential for the prevention of dangerous situations and for the co-ordination and control of rescues. Ideally, every member should hold the R.O.C. The R.O.C. is available to every member - Active, family or associate over fifteen years of age who is willing to sit for a test on elementary Radio operation.

The training has gone well this season. I am pleased that we now have sufficient members of well trained members capable of providing a good standard of service to the public.
